

**The UOB Heartbeat Run / Walk and Family Day 2012
Shares Goodness for the Future of Indonesian
Children**

Sunday, 13 May 2012 - PT Bank UOB Indonesia ("UOBI") held the UOB Heartbeat Run / Walk and Family Day 2012 at UOB Plaza, Jl. M.H. Thamrin No. Jakarta 10230. This is a Family Gathering as well as a UOBI Corporate Social Responsibility ("CSR") program which focuses on 3 (three) pillars, namely children, education, and the arts. This event was also held simultaneously in UOB regional in Indonesia, Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand and China annually.

All the donations made by UOBI are contributions from all UOBI employees, companies and partners.

In addition to the CSR program carried out at The UOB Heartbeat Run / Walk and Family Day 2012, UOBI also held a 6 km running race and a 4 km healthy walk attended by more than 4,000 participants, including UOBI employees and their families and partners. The event was enlivened by the UOBI Star activity - a singing competition between UOBI employees and UOBI Kids Choir, which is a choir of children of UOBI employees. UOBI Kids Choir will present a song composed by Josh Heroe, which is a song of aspirations for children to make their dreams come true. In addition, various play tents that can improve children's intelligence are also provided in this event.
