UOB Indonesia raises awareness on the importance of marine biodiversity to underprivileged children in Bali

More than 200 UOB volunteers accompanied the children to release sea turtles to their habitat

Bali, 3 April 2023 – UOB Indonesia empowered its colleagues to raise awareness on the importance of marine biodiversity to underprivileged children in Bali. This programme is part of UOB Indonesia's commitment to educate young children about protecting our surrounding environment for a sustainable future.

Through this educational programme, children who lived nearby Tanjong Benoa were given the experience to learn about the sea turtles' conservation and their role in maintaining the world's ocean balance with a fun story telling. Ms Irene Febry, winner of the 2021 UOB Painting of the Year, Silver Award, Emerging Artist Category, led the session with creative arts and encouraged children to create a collage of sea turtles from beach waste such as fishing rods and plastic bags.

In collaboration with Bulih Bali, a turtle conservation fisherman group, more than 200 UOB Indonesia volunteers joined the children in the release of 50 baby sea turtles and eight rescued sea turtles back to their habitat. This experience enabled the children to learn about the importance of protecting endangered species while keeping the ocean clean from pollution.

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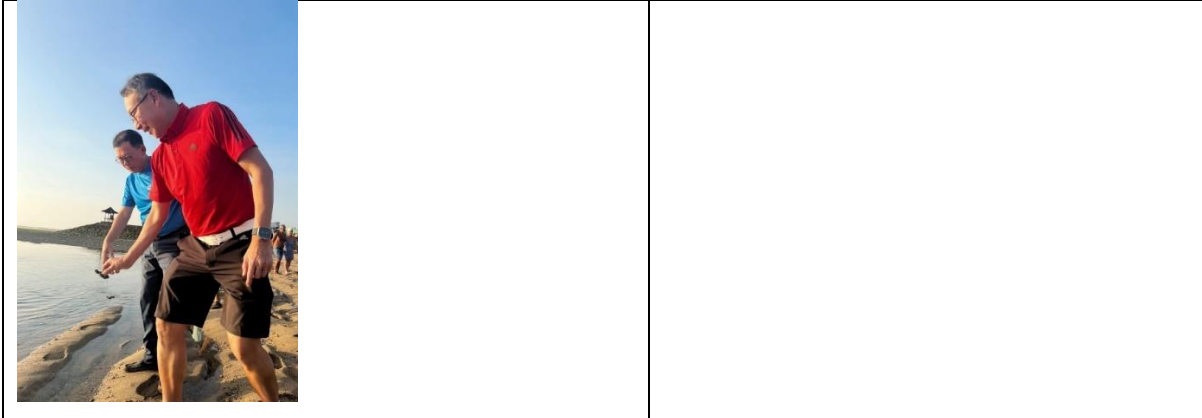
